- Mobilising the resources from Don Bosco alumni to contribute to the emancipation of the marginalised section of the society.



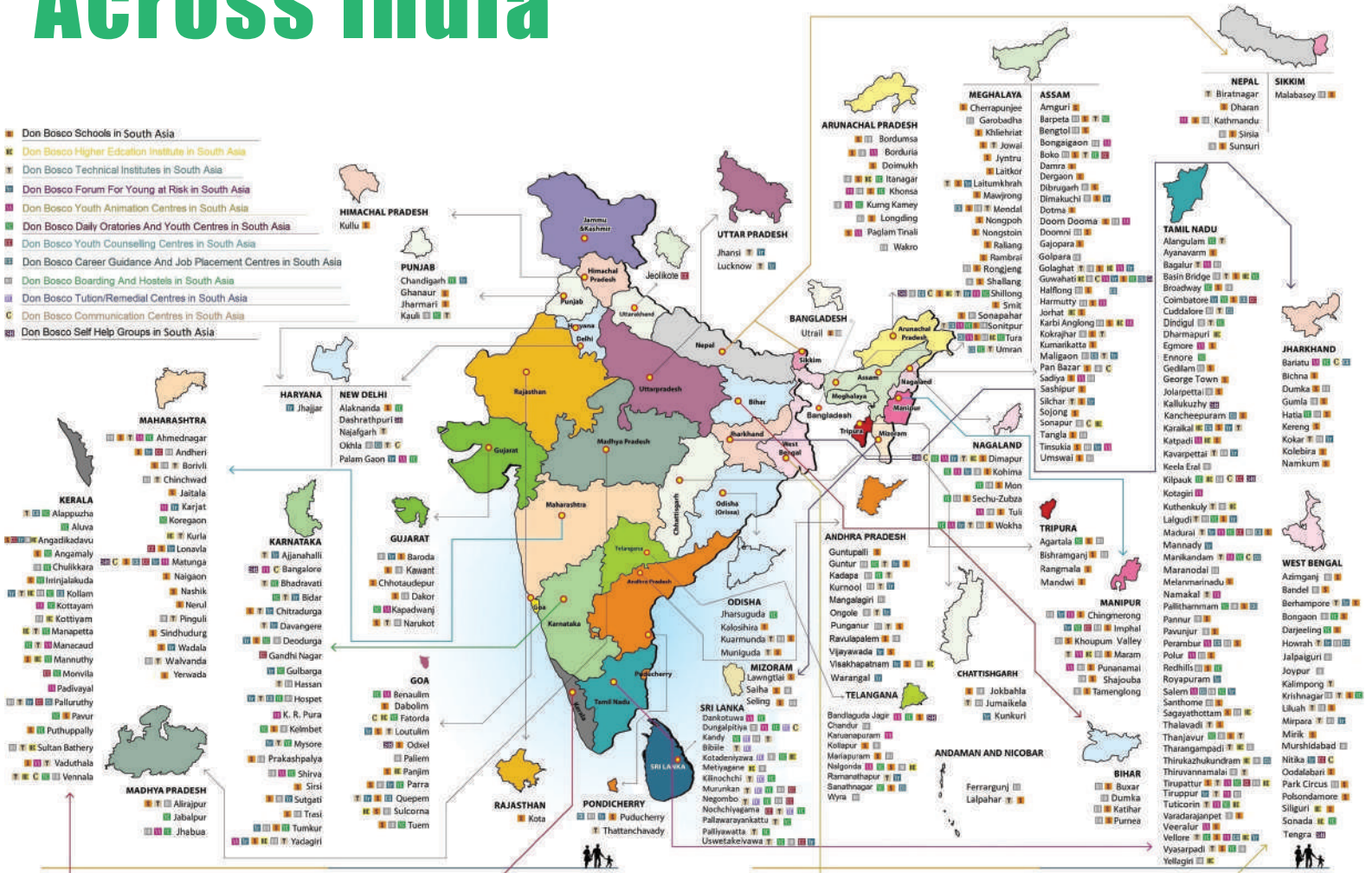

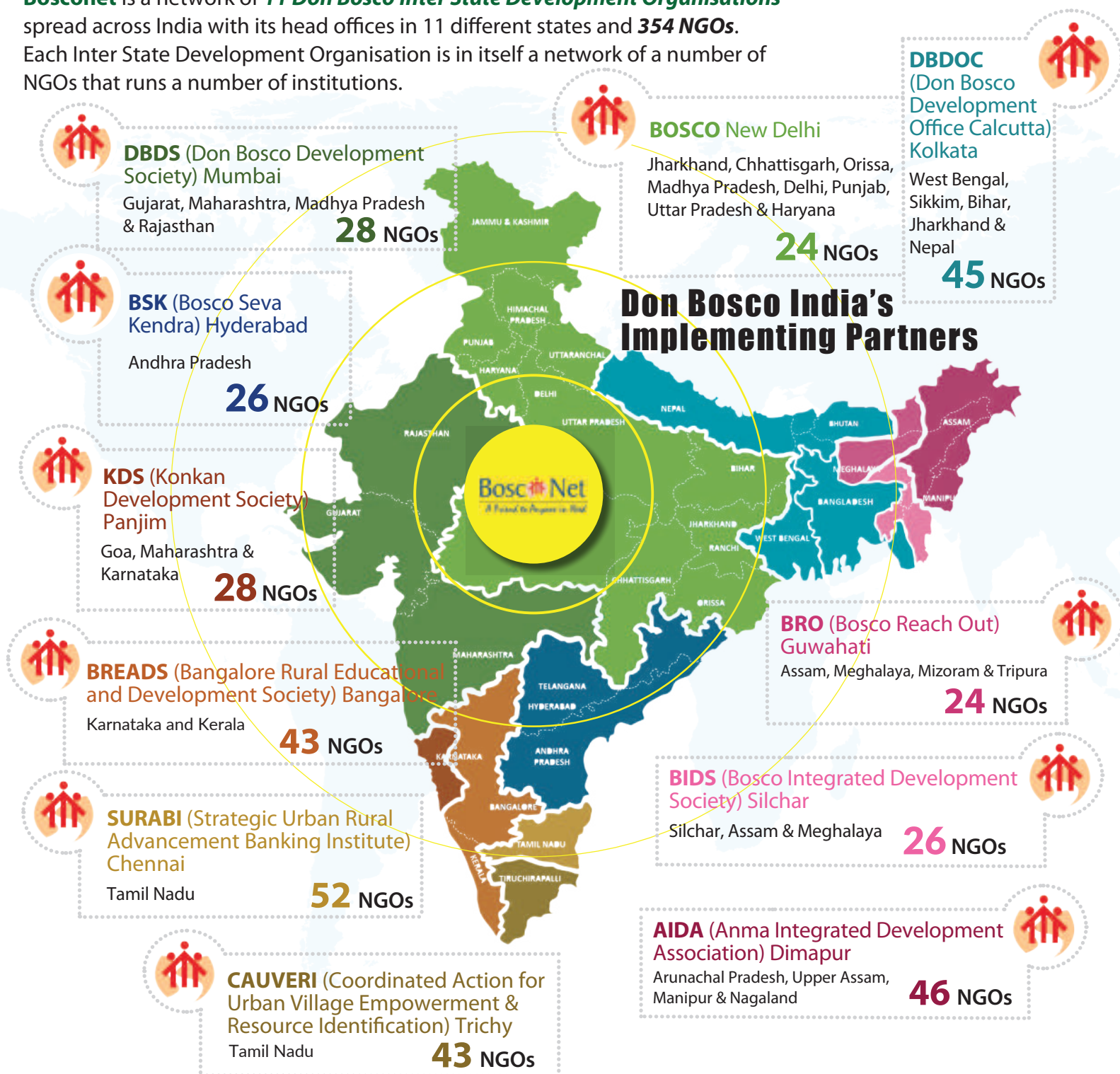
